"The Ladder" is a multiple sculpture of marble, wood, and neon created by Peticov in 1982. It is 60cm high, 22cm deep, and 33cm wide.

Peticov was born in 1946 in the village of Assis on the outskirts of Sao Paulo, Brazil. He spent much of his youth in the wide open South American countryside where he developed a deep appreciation of the natural phenomenon and structural harmony underlying nature.

Peticov began painting at the age of 12 and was intent on a career as an artist. He has travelled extensively and boasts more than 40 group shows and 22 one-man exhibits.



A common theme in Peticov's work is the brightly colored, somewhat surreal landscape of his youth. His deep spirituality and mystical awareness are often depicted in his work by a recurring visual component — the seven colors of the spectrum.
